Release and Behavior Agreement

(Rev. 1/30/12 CRR)

I hereby make application to enter the Johnson County 4-H Dog Club and agree to:

- regularly attend meetings
- bring my dog, proper leash, proper collar, treats, clicker, and any other needed equipment
- abide by the rules and regulations of the club
- faithfully carry out the recommendations of the leaders
- train my dog to the best of my ability
- do additional leader recommended training of my dog between meetings

I understand that attendance at a dog meeting contains risk to me, members of my family, guests, and my dogs. Some of the dogs to which I will be exposed may be difficult to control and could be the cause of injury even when handled with the greatest degree of care.

I agree to hold the leaders harmless for any claims for any loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of my dog while in, upon, or near the entrance there to the training areas. I personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim. I further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless for any claim for damage or injury to my dog, whether such loss, theft, disappearance, damage, or injury be caused or be alleged to be caused by the negligence of the party aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I agree to the following rules:

1. I must be able to control the dog and keep the dog 3-6 feet from any other dog before, during, and after the 4-H dog activities. The parent may need to provide physical assistance, and/or an appropriate training device (slip collar, martingale collar, head halter, or harness) to enable the 4-H member to control the dog. Training aids are used for training only, and their use is to be faded out. They are not allowed in the show ring.
2. I will follow the directions of the leaders during the activities. The first violation will require that the 4-H member and dog sit out of the activity for 15 minutes in a designated area. The 4-H member is to watch and listen to the training, but may not participate during that time. A second violation during the same activity will require that the 4-H member and dog sit with the parent for the remainder of the activity. The 4-H member is to watch and listen, but not participate for the remainder of that activity.
3. I must clean up after my dogs. Bring plastic bags and paper towels to each 4-H dog activity. Keep a plastic bag in your pocket at all times during activities. Feces and vomit must be cleaned up immediately and completely from the ground or floor. Urine must be cleaned from the floor, building, and equipment.
4. Dogs with fleas or ticks are not allowed at 4-H dog activities.
5. Dogs not registered for the project (including puppies) may not come to 4-H dog activities.
6. I must wear safe, secure footwear and appropriate clothing during 4-H dog activities. These are specified in the Johnson 4-H County Handbook.
7. If I am under 16, then my parent or other responsible adult must remain at any 4-H dog activities.
